



West O'ahu/Farrington Highway Guideway Contract

Kiewit Field Work Roadwork and Traffic Update Week of August 21, 2011

Traffic Impacts:

- Crews will work along Farrington Highway between Ala Ike Street in Pearl City and Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) in Kapolei. Work will consist of:
 - Drilling for soil samples along the H-1 Freeway Waipahu on-and off-ramps between Kamehameha Highway and Farrington Highway.
 - Shaft work within the median of Farrington Highway between Leoku Street and Leokane Street.
 - Trimming and relocating trees within the median of Farrington Highway from Aniani Place to Pupukahi Street.
 - Utility relocation work along the shoulder of Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road)

Evening Traffic Impacts

- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Paiwa Street and Kahuali'i Street relocating utilities.

Farrington Highway, H-1 and City Streets Traffic Plan:

- Day work will require lane closures from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. with shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area.
- Night work will require lane closures from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. with median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.

Please observe all traffic signs, anticipate possible delays, use alternative routes and drive with ALOHA as your safety and the safety of the workers is of the highest importance.
